Fasting and Abstinence During Lent
Fasting & Abstinence on Ash Wednesday
and Good Friday: Traditionally, fasting
consists of eating only one meal, with the
possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add
up to a full meal.

Abstinence from Meat on Fridays: Canon 1251 specifies that Catholics refrain from eating meat on Fridays, as an act of penance. In the US, Catholics are permitted to substitute another penance outside of the season of Lent. During Lent, however, all Catholics are obliged not to eat meat on Fridays.

Penance during Lent: The season of Lent is a penitential time, and it should be marked by some form of self-denial.

The law of abstinence applies to all persons over the age of 14; the law of fasting applies to those between ages 18 and 59. Those who are sick, pregnant or nursing, or whose health would be adversely affected by fasting or abstinence should not consider themselves bound by these norms.

AYUNO Y ABSTINENCIA DURANTE LA CUARESMA:

Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días obligatorios de ayuno y abstinencia para los católicos. Además, los viernes durante la Cuaresma son días de abstinencia obligatoria.

Para los miembros de la Iglesia católica latina, las normas sobre el ayuno es obligatorio desde los 18 años hasta los 59 años. Cuando se ayuna, una persona se le permite comer una comida completa. Dos comidas más pequeñas también se pueden tomar, pero no equivalen a una comida completa. Las personas que están enfermas, embarazadas o que están amamantando no tienen que seguir estas normas.

Las normas relativas a la abstinencia de carne son vinculantes para los miembros de la Iglesia católica latina de 14 años de edad en adelante.
