Maintaining a Catholic Consciousness in the World Today

Beginning in 2006, the following Catholic Charities have been forced to close its foster care/adoption services agency: Boston, San Francisco, Buffalo and all of Illinois. Surprised?

In each case, in order to comply with state regulations barring sexual discrimination in allowing same sex couples to foster and adopt children, these agencies would not be able to conform to the teaching of the Roman Catholic Church worldwide, which recognizes marriage as only a union between a man and a woman. These agencies were committed to this teaching and to placing needy and vulnerable children with married couples so that each child would have the experience of a mom and a dad. No religious exemption was provided, and they were forced to shut down.

The Church reminds us that our participation in shaping the moral character of our society is a requirement of our faith. In the Catholic tradition, we are reminded that we are to make decisions in the ballot box based more on our moral convictions rather than due to our political affiliation. Our Church does not tell us how to vote but rather asks us to make responsible choices, guided by a properly formed conscience, in order to promote the wellbeing of all.

We are to do good, not evil. What does that mean in our Catholic tradition?

Catholic social teaching revolves around seven key ideas:

- Life is sacred, from conception to natural death. Intrinsic evils such as abortion, human cloning and euthanasia must be always opposed.
- The family, based on marriage between a man and a woman, is the fundamental unit of society. Respect for the family should be reflected in every policy and program.
- All human beings have certain rights (i.e., life, religious freedom, decent shelter, food, education, work opportunities...), and there are duties and responsibilities that correspond to those rights, both to each other and to the greater society at large.
- Concern for the poor and vulnerable among us should take a high priority.
- The dignity of work and workers' rights
- Solidarity: we are one human family, and what affects one of us, affects all of us.
- Careful stewardship of God's creation

Before you go to vote on November 6, please take time to use the principles of Catholic social teaching to look at each candidate's positions on the issues as well as his/her integrity, performance and philosophy, in order to make the best choices. YOUR VOTE COUNTS!!
